

**Protocol for Submission of Affidavit by Attorney Seeking Admission to
Practice in Mississippi as a Pro Bono Publicus Attorney
With Mission First Legal Aid Office**

The Mississippi Bar Office of General Counsel receives and approves the affidavit submitted by an attorney who is seeking admission to practice in Mississippi as a Pro Bono Publicus Attorney through Mission First Legal Aid Office.

An attorney seeking admission as a Pro Bono Publicus Attorney must execute an affidavit (see sample affidavit on Legal Aid Office website) and send the original to the Office of General Counsel for approval. Once an attorney is approved, the Office of General Counsel will notify Mission First so that the process of assigning work to the attorney may begin.
